RE: Crustless Peanut Butter & Grape Jelly Film Issue

Dear Heather,

It was brought to our attention that customers who have purchased product through McLane are having trouble scanning the barcode due to the UPC code being different. We immediately began reviewing this, and determined that a roll of #831-40 PB & Grape on Whole Grain (“white wheat”) was pulled to the production floor on April 29th, 2022 during production of Item #47141-24 PB & Grape on White Bread. This mistake affected *only a portion* of Lot #22119. The following locations were shipped product from this lot and may or may not be affected:

- McLane Southwest, Temple TX, PO #SW10033070-01 – 77 cases
- McLane Sunwest, Goodyear AZ, PO #MS10025199-01 – 150 cases
- McLane NE/Concord, Hopkinton NH, PO #MY10026663-01 – 195 cases
- McLane Northeast, Baldwinsville NY, PO #NE10029863-01 – 105 cases
- McLane Midwest, Danville IL, PO #MI10032279-01 – 105 cases
- McLane Cumberland, Nicholasville KY, PO #MK10030673-01 – 210 cases
- McLane Ozark, Republic MO, PO #MO10031764-01 – 210 cases

We acknowledge this error and have added to our Corrective and Preventative Action plan to help prevent this from happening in the future. This does not constitute a food safety issue or recall, and there are only minor differences in the film that was used, which includes the description of “white wheat bread” on the front of the package, and a barcode number of 020018008317 on the back.

We will offer our help with either being able to sell through this product, or have the affected product discarded for credit, per your instruction. Your understanding of this matter is appreciated. We continue to be dedicated to providing you with high quality product.
